

G.S. Writes....

Second hazardous wave of Corona-19 is nearing to end but it has taken away number of near & dear one of our members; which can be seen from the condolence's pages in this issue. I was perturbed, moved and mentally disturbed while receiving daily three to four such messages of members demise. We have also lost our active workers in pandemic. Ironical moment came when I had to place news of my life partner on 10th July, 2021. We have to take consolation that it is God's will and we all humane being are helpless in front of him.

Now, it is not end of pandemic, we are again and again warned of third wave which may strike in near future. We have to take all precautions to meet with the situation and can not become carefree. We can not be always confined indoor but while attending urgent and inevitable activities all care has to be exercised. Our kids concern for us is natural when they have seen such tragic events in neighborhood and relatives.

We have to struggle against anti-pensioners mindset of the administration and we will continue to struggle. We have before us number of incidents where BSNL Managements have issued number of impractical orders and have modified again and again. Asking for Option for 2021-21 and renewal of medical card are fresh examples in our memory. In order to justify their failure to post, prepare, check and finalize medical claims of BSNL Pensioners; they are issuing orders seeking the information which is already available with them. **They say, on line option can be given, but No CGMs or SSA Heads have followed the instruction excepting circulating the same.** We fail to understand what prevents them to have clear cut instructions. Many CGMs have issued clarificatory orders but till the time of

writing this, we have not received any clear instructions from the Corporate office. Result is each CGM is issuing clarification as per his wish. The CGM Gujarat has asked for option for 2021-22 but not provided on line information nor extended the time limit. Similar situations prevail throughout country. Those who have switchover to CGHS are eligible for medical claims as per their option till date, but nowhere any mention of such cases is mentioned. Result, the administrative office will close their cases without asking for any clarification from Corporate Office. In many places Medical Identity Card are having no space for renewal but instead of issuing fresh cards, they are renewed writing wherever space is available.

Frozen C.D.A. for Central Govt. Employees / Pensioners is released w.e.f. 01.07.2021 and separate orders for Employees/Pensioners are already issued. We expect issuance of such orders before this issue come into your hand.

Our struggle to get IDA arrears for frozen period will continue and as per view taken by judiciaries, there is ample possibility to get it. It is strange that BSNL Corporate Office issues orders for vaccination for working employees by making special arrangements but never mention the pensioners which could be easily done. They accord priority for payment of vaccination for employees but the Pensioners have to wait...

Now issue of main concerns for all us is to be on safer side and save ourselves from third wave of pandemic which is expected in August 2021; spreading with double speed then previous one. As Govt. is taking very cautious steps and not prepared for lockdown as it creates multiple issues for survival of citizens and economy of country gets adversely effected. So let us, accept our voluntary restrictions, not to move out of house unless it is warranted, not to attend marriage/birthday parties, not to visit relatives in hospitals, always wear Mask, to take bath each time when you go out and come back to your home. Ensure that your family members are also not going out of your house without any necessity.

If the situation once again become worse, it will not be prudent for us to stage rallies, demonstrations or Dharna for strengthening our just, genuine and legal demands. We have to suit with the time and wait for improvement in pandemic situation.

We have before us, result of legal battles fought by some Pensioners Associations and also Working Employees. Though they have won, its interpretation by the authorities have not permitted even an inch to have such judgments implementation.

A very simple and accepted concept that all likeminded Unions/Associations should get them united and struggle jointly legal battles as well. A beginning has been made by AUAB. Let's us be sincere in our united struggle.

Anomaly case won by the Associations is facing same fate, though cleared by Apex Court, filed contempt petitions; it is yet to be implemented.

Many employees have taken advantage of VRS-2019 Scheme, and we request to those who can spare their time for Pensioners Welfare, should join Pensioners Associations of their choice and made the Pensioners Struggle strong. New leadership to help the veterans is call of time to continue our journey comfortably.

OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Subject: Revised rates of Dearness Relief to Central Government Pensioners / Family w.e.f. 01.07.2021

The undersigned is directed to refer to Ministry of Finance (Department of Expenditure) Office Memorandum No. 1/1/2020-E-11(B), dated 23.04.2020, vide which instalments of Dearness Relief to pensioners/family pensioners due from 01.01.2020, 01.07.2020 and 01.01.2021, were frozen and to say that the President is pleased to decide that the Dearness Relief admissible to Central Government pensioners/family pensioners shall be enhanced from the existing rate of 17% to 28% of the basic pension/family pension (including additional pension/family pension) with effect from 1st July 2021. The increase subsumes the additional instalments arising on 01.01.2020, 01.07.2020 and 01.01.2021. The rate of Dearness Relief, earlier determined vide this Department's OM No. 42/04/2019- P&PV(D) dated 21.10.2019, shall remain at 17% of basic pension/family pension for the period from 01.01.2020 till 30.06.2021.

2. These rates of Dearness Relief will be applicable to:

- Civilian Central Government Pensioners / Family Pensioners including Central Government absorbed pensioners in PSU/Autonomous Bodies in respect of whom orders have been issued vide this Department's OM No. 4/34/2002-P&PW(D) Vo1.11 dated 23.06.2017 for restoration of full pension after expiry of commutation period of 15 years.
- The Armed Forces pensioners/family pensioners and Civilian pensioners/ family pensioners paid out of the Defence Service Estimates.
- All India Services pensioners/family pensioners.
- Railway pensioners/family pensioners.
- Pensioners who are in receipt of provisional pension.

- vi. The Burma Civilian pensioners/family pensioners and displaced pensioners/famil) pensioners from Pakistan, in respect of whom orders have been issued vide this Department's OM No. 23/3/200X-P&PW(B) dated 11.09.2017.
3. The payment of Dearness Relief involving a fraction of a rupee shall be rounded off to the next higher rupee.
4. Other provisions governing grant of Dearness Relief in respect of employed family pensioners and re-employed Central Government Pensioners will be regulated in accordance with the provisions contained in this Department's OM No. 45/73/97-P&PW (G), dated 2.7.1999, as amended from time to time. The provisions relating to regulation of Dearness Relief where a pensioner is in receipt of more than one pension will remain unchanged.
5. In the case of retired Judges of the Supreme Court and High Courts, necessary orders will be issued by the Department of Justice separately.
6. It will be the responsibility of the pension disbursing authorities, including the nationalized banks, etc. to calculate the quantum of Dearness Relief payable in each individual case.
7. The offices of Accountant General and authorised Pension Disbursing Banks are requested to arrange payment of relief to pensioners etc. on the basis of these instructions without waiting for any further instructions from the Comptroller and Auditor General of India and the Reserve Bank of India in view of letter No. 528-TA. II/34-80-11, dated 23/04/1981, of the Comptroller and Auditor General of India addressed to all Accountant Generals and Reserve Bank of India Circular No. GANB No. 2958/GA-64 (ii) (CGL)/81 dated the 21st May, 1981 addressed to State Bank of India and its subsidiaries and all Nationalised Banks.
8. In their application to the persons belonging to Indian Audit and Accounts Department, these orders are issued under Article 148(5) of the Constitution and after consultation with the Comptroller & Auditor General of India.
9. These issues in pursuance of Ministry of Finance. Department of Expenditure's OM

No. 1/1/2020-E. 11(B) dated 20th July, 2021.

DEMAND FOR ARREAR FOR FROZEN IDA IS MADE BY NATIONAL COUNCIL JCM

Shri Shiva Gopal Mishra, Secretary, National Council (Staff Side) writes to Cabinet Secretary GOI, New Delhi for payment of C.D.A. Arrears.

Sub:- Payment of Dearness Allowance/ DR w.e.f. 01/01/2020, 01/07/2020 and 01/01/2021 with arrears

Dear Sir,

At the outset we are grateful to the Government that after considering the repeated representations made by the Staff Side including in the National Council - JCM meeting held under your Chairmanship on 26/06/2021, the Government have now decided to release the DA/DR to Central Government employees and Pensioners w.e.f 1/07/2021. Accordingly the DA / DR has been increased to 28% representing an increase of 11% over the existing rate of 17% of Basic Pay / Pension. The increased DA / DR is actually due from 1/1/2020, 01/07/2020 and 01/01/2021, however it is regretted to note that the Government has decided that the rate of Dearness allowance / DR for the period 01/01/2020 to 30/06/2021 shall remain at 17%. This is not at all justified, since the DA/DR is a part of the wages of the employees and pension of the pensioners and any arbitrary recovery of the same will amount to illegal recovery of wages and pension. It is also pertinent to mention here that the employees who retired from service between 01/01/2020 and 30/06/2021 are subjected to huge financial loss in their gratuity and leave encashment for no fault of theirs since they are all denied the benefit of DA due to them. In the last National Council - JCM meeting the Staff Side demanded for payment of the three installments of DA / DR due to the employees/ Pensioners with arrears w.e.f 01/01/2020. The staff Side also proposed that the Staff Side is prepared to discuss about the mode of arrears payment.

Here we would like invite to your kind attention to the Judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India delivered on 08/02/2021 in Civil Appeal No. 399 of 2021 (Arising out of SLP (C) No. 12553 of 2020. The Hon'ble Supreme Court has decided that salaries and pension constitutes the right full entitlement of the employees and are payable in accordance with law. The relevant portion of the Judgment is given below for your kind ready reference

14. The direction for the payment of the deferred portions of the salaries and pensions is unexceptionable. Salaries are due to the employees of the State for services rendered. Salaries in other words constitute the rightful entitlement of the employees and are payable in accordance with law. Likewise, it is well settled that the payment of pension is for years of past service rendered by the pensioners to the State. Pensions are hence a matter of a rightful entitlement recognized by the applicable rules and regulations which govern the service of the employees of the State. The State Government has complied with the directions of this Court for the payment of the outstanding dues in two tranches. Insofar as the interest is concerned, we are of the view that the rate of 12% per annum which has been fixed by the High Court should be suitably scaled down. While learned counsel for the respondents submits that the award of interest was on account of the action of the Government which was contrary to law, we are of the view that the payment of interest cannot be used as a means to penalize the State Government. There can be no gainsaying the fact that the Government which has delayed the payment of salaries and pensions should be directed to pay interest at an appropriate rate.

15. We accordingly order and direct that in substitution of the interest rate of 12% per annum which has been awarded by the High Court, the Government of Andhra Pradesh shall pay simple interest computed at the rate of 6% per annum on account of deferred salaries and pensions within a period of thirty days from today. This direction shall, however in the facts and circumstances, be confined to categories 3, 4, 5 and 6 of GOMs No 26 dated 31 March 2020. We clarify that interest shall be paid to all pensioners of the State at the rate of 6% per annum on the deferred portion, for the period of delay. Having regard to the prevailing bank interest, the rate of 12% per annum which has been fixed by the High Court, would need to be and is accordingly reduced.

In view of the above judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court the law is now established that Government cannot permanently freeze the salary and the pension. Therefore the frozen three installment of DA/DR due from 01/01/2020, 01/07/2020 ar'd 01/01/2021 i.e. additional 4% from 01/01/2020, 7% from 01/07/2021 and 11% from 01/01/2021 may please be paid as arrears to the employees and pensioners. You will also appreciate that the arrears amount wil increase the cash inflow in the market which will ultimately benefit the economy of the country. A copy of the Hon'ble Supreme Court Judgment dated 08/02/2021 is enclosed with this letter for your kind perusal.

Subject: Submission of LC/DLC by DoT pensioners (SAMPANN/FMS) at any CCA office.

It has been observed that SAMPANN/FMS pensioners may face difficulties in submitting their Physical Life Certificates when they reside in a circle other than the circle which issued the PPO which could lead to delays and thereby stoppage of pension. Additionally, in case of Digital Life Certificate (DI-C1 via Jervan Pramaan, it has been observed that sometimes the DL is submitted to a CCA office other than concerned CCA office unknowingly by pensioners and therefore the details are not updated in the system(s).

Therefore, for convenience of pensioners, I am directed to convey the following:

1. DoT pensioners receiving pension via SAMPANN/Financial Management System can submit their Physical Life Certificate in any nearby CCA office. To ensure successful updation of Life Certificate, the following immediate steps may be taken:
 - a. Recipient CCA should scan the Physical Life Certificate and send the soft copy to the concerned CCA Office via an official email ID.
 - b. Subsequently, recipient CCA should send the hard copy in original by Post as well.
 - c. Concerned CCA Office may update the Life Certificate details based on the soft copy received.
2. For Digital Life Certificate via Jervan Pramaan submitted incorrectly by the pensioner, the following step may be taken:
 - a. The recipient CCA, on identification of the concerned CCA, may share the data immediately with that concerned CCA via an official email ID

Pr. CCA/CCA Offices are requested to inform pensioners and Pensioners Associations via means of letters/SMS/Call regarding the above.

EXTRACTS OF THE JUDGEMENT...

14. The Bank is a trustee of the account of the pensioners, like the petitioner, and has no authority in the eyes of law to dispute the entitlement of the pension payable to the employees, other than those in the employment of the Bank. To tamper with such account and effect the recovery of pension without any authority, is nothing but a breach of trust of the petitioner by the Bank. We should not be understood to have said that even where there is technical error in calculation, other than of entitlement, is committed resulting in excess payment, the Bank cannot recover it. We have already held that no such case is made out here.

16. Before parting with this Judgment, we need to remind the Bank that the pension payable to the employees upon superannuation is a 'property' under Article 300-A of the Constitution of India and it constitutes a fundamental right to livelihood under Article 21 of the Constitution of India. The deprivation, even a part of this amount, cannot be accepted, except in accordance with and authority of law. Article 41 of the Constitution of India in the Part IV of Directive Principles of State Policy has created an obligation upon the State to recognize a right of public assistance in the case of old age, sickness and disablement. Article 46 therein requires the State to promote with special care the economic interests of the weaker sections of the people. In short, the aforesaid provisions of the directive principles of State policy create an obligation upon the State to enact suitable laws, making the provisions to recognize a right of public assistance, to promote economic interests, to protect the life and property of senior citizens, to treat them with respect and dignity and to give wide publicity to it.

17. Unfortunately, the time has come to tell the Bank that the aging is natural process, which leads to weakening of the body and mind. The productivity, working ability and mobility decreases or paralyzes with growing age. The traditional norms, values and culture in the Indian Society demand to treat the senior citizens with respect, dignity and lay stress on providing security, care and assistance to them. It becomes a part of the human right of the senior citizens

The senior citizens are the persons who had shouldered the responsibility of building a nation in general and society or community in particular, while in service. Utilizing their experience in the life and working, the strong shoulders are created of young persons to substitute and rest the responsibility upon them, while demitting the office. The bank officials must realize that tomorrow it may be their turn, upon superannuation, to fight for the pension or post-retiral benefits. The thought process, therefore, to be adopted should be of a person in a

situation like the petitioner. The respect, dignity, care, sensitivity, assistance and security would automatically follow.

18. We have, however, seen and can take judicial note of the fact that the security of the senior citizens always remain in peril. We have seen the senior citizens anxiously waiting for credit of the pension amount in their account and standing in a queue for withdrawal. Once the amount is withdrawn personally either from the Bank or from the ATM, a serious threat starts posing to the life from the watchdogs roaming around involved in pick-pocketing and stealing. We have actually seen the old aged persons – men and women, counting the currency with cramping hands and trying to secure the amount at some hidden place in the body. It is then after waiting in the premises of the Bank and taking stock of the situation and the atmosphere with scared mind and the feeling of insecurity, the escape route and time is chosen to reach to their destination safely. It is a high time for the Banks to create a separate cell and to devise a method to provide personal service through the men of confidence, at the doorstep to the old aged, disabled and sick persons who are the senior citizens. They have to be treated with respect and dignity. The sensitivity to the problems of the senior citizens need to be addressed. The mechanism for immediate redressal of grievance needs to be provided. The officers having a degree or master's degree in Social Work or Psychology, who can be in personal touch with and genuinely understand and redress the grievances or complaints of the senior citizens, can be appointed.

19. In the result, this petition is allowed and the following order is passed:

(1) The action of the respondent No.3- Bank in deducting an amount of Rs.11,040/- per month with effect from October, 2019 is hereby quashed and set aside.

(2) We direct the respondent No.3- Bank to immediately credit an amount of Rs.3,27,045/-, recovered from the pension account of the petitioner, along with interest at the rate of 18% per annum from the date of recovery of each of the installments, till the date of credit of this amount in the pension account of the petitioner.

(3) The respondent No.3- Bank is restrained from recovering any amount from the pension payable to the petitioner on the basis of the action, which we have quashed and set aside.

(4) We direct the respondent No.3- Bank to pay the compensation of Rs.50,000/- to the petitioner and credit the said amount in the pension account of the petitioner within a period of eight days from today, failing which the additional costs of Rs.1,000/- for each day's delay will have to be paid.

(5) We direct the Registry of this Court to forward the copies of this Judgment to the Centralized Processing Pension Centres of all the Nationalized Banks and also to the Reserve Bank of India and the Chief Secretary, Government of Maharashtra, to consider the question of constitution of separate cell and release of appropriate guidelines so as to attain the constitutional goal of providing respect, dignity, care, sensitivity, assistance and security to all the pension account holders in banks.

Sir,

At present a large number of cases are reported / received from Circles regarding the recovery of excess/wrong payments made to VRS optees/retired employees in BSNL. These cases are filed for seeking wavier for the excess/wrongful payment made to them, by quoting the Hon'ble Supreme Court judgment in Civil Appeal No. 1157 of 2014 between State of Punjab and other versus Rafiq Masih.

A careful perusal of the above judgment will show that the Hon'ble Supreme Court does not give any relief to employees other than Gr 'C' & 'D' ,who are due to retire within one year of the date of order of recovery.

Instances have come to notice where employees other than Gr. 'C' and 'D' are also seeking relief by quoting the Rafiq Masih judgment, which is only meant to aid employees of poor financial status i.e. Gr. 'C' & 'D' to whom recovery would be iniquitous.

Therefore, whenever any petition is filed by executive(s), their cases may be defended on individual basis on merits of the case. The relevant facts, may be incorporated while filing the counter affidavit to buttress that Rafiq Masih judgment is not applicable to them.

Further, in High Court of Punjab and

Haryana and ors Vs Jagdev Singh (2016) 14 SCC 267, the Hon'ble Supreme Court held that the principle of non-recovery from retired employees would not apply in the case of an employee put on notice at the time of payment that any excess payment made, would be required to be refunded.

Further it may be noted that though the recovery of over payment in few situations have been termed as impermissible in law by the Hon'ble Supreme Court, **the judgment does not in any manner prevent rectification of error, if any, that has occurred during re-fixation of pay of the employees. Hence, it may be ensured that the rectification of the error is carried out without any fail at the earliest and that their terminal benefits including leave encashment, Ex-gratia (in VRS cases), etc., are finalised as per the corrected pay.**

Also, wherever any excess payments has been made on account of fraud, misrepresentation, collusion, favouritism, negligence and carelessness etc., role of those responsible for over a ments in such cases and the employees who benefited from such actions should be identified and disciplinary/criminal action should be initiated in appropriate cases for the loss caused to BSNL.

In this connection already detailed instructions have been conveyed to all circles vide this office letters of even No. dated 09/09/2016, 23/03/2017, 19/09/2017 and 04/03/2020.

Therefore Circles are requested to defend the Court Cases pertaining to the excess/wrongful payment in accordance with the above instructions.

This issues with the approval of the Competent Authority.

Sub: Revalidation of BSNL Medical Card and payment of Cash Allowance with/without vouchers facilities to retired Employees – A Request to modify BSNLCO Letter dated 07.07.2021.

Sir, we write to convey our heartiest greetings on your becoming our most respected Communication Minister who is equipped with all resources to understand the issues of Sr. Citizens – in our case BSNL Retirees – and to minimize their hardships by adopting reasonable and just humane

procedure keeping in view their age-related issues. Sir, by this letter we wish to bring to your kind notice how the pensioners are systematically placed in agonistic situation and have to run from pillar to post for get their legitimate rights available to them.

Through this letter we wish to bring to your kind notice, such one example for your knowledge. We are fully aware that you have multiple responsibilities and it will be nearly unreasonable for us to expect to take your time but the circumstances have placed into such a situation that we can not keep silence. We cite one example as under:

1. BSNL Corporate office has issued instruction vide his No: BSNLCO/4/2021 dated 7th July 2021 citing its earlier orders dated 08.05.2020 and 10.06.2020 on the subject "Revalidation of BSNL Medical Card and payment of Cash Allowance with/without vouchers facilities to retired Employees" (Copy enclosed.)
2. On face value, it seems simple and no one should have any grievance had it been issued for current financial year 2021-22.
3. For your kind information, since 2019-20 onwards BSNL Pensioners have not received their in-door/out-door medical claims who has opted with vouchers.
4. Also, who have opted for fixed cash medical amount without vouchers have not received their payment, which will be Rs.24000 per pensioners. Needless to say, that though they have incurred huge expenditure towards their outdoor medical treatment, due to their old age, inability to personally visit the office and save themselves from humiliation, they have opted for the fixed amount.
5. **We therefore seek your kind favour to accept all the Options for with and without vouchers and for CGHS for the year 2019-20 and 2020-21, which are already received by the respective office may be treated as final and suitable early action should be initiated to effect the payment.**
6. Further, the present order may be implemented for the current year 2021-22

and date for submission should be kept as 30th September 2021 and clear instruction for online acceptance of option with required details and option forms maybe initiated by the BSNL Corporate office.

7. Further in order to relieve from the burden of medical payment, dialogue should be initiated with health ministry to issue the CGHS Medical cards to all the BSNL Pensioners who are opting for the same and the payment against such facilities should be given by BSNL Corporate Office as per availability of finance in a phased manner.

Sir, we look ward to have sympathetic consideration to our prayer and save the senior citizen from further agonies.

Administrative Charges

Due to loss of magazine, we are trying to send one copy till the stock is available. We have curtailed list of complementary copies as well to contain the expenditure. Though the magazine was costing rupees 150/- we have tried to supply the same at half cost but we cannot afford to continue it further. Posting of Birthday Card is discontinued and we may start soon with

available of required resources to meet with expenditure. Please co-operate and make your organization strong and viable to sustain uninterrupted publication of magazine. This will minimize our administrative work. Please note that subscription commence from 1st April each year for four issues.

We collect only Rs.100/- as administrative charges towards magazine and remittance of extra copy add further expenditure to the Association. So, we request you to kindly cooperate.

In view of the Corona Virus Disease (COVID-19), all out efforts are made by the

Government to contain its impact by instituting measures at community as well as at individual level.

2. In this regard the undersigned is directed to draw attention is the OM of even number dated 27.03.2020, 29.04.2020, 29.05.2020 , 24th August 2020, 30th September 2020 and 29.12.2020 vide which an option has been provided to CGHS beneficiaries getting medicines for Chronic diseases, to purchase medicines based on the prescription held (prescribed by CGHS Medical Officers/ CGHS Specialists/ other Govt. Specialists/ Specialist of empaneled hospital) till 28th February 2021, irrespective of Non-Availability certificate from CGHS or otherwise. However, several representations are received in the Ministry seeking extension of the period in view of the COVID-19 Pandemic resurgence.

3. The matter has been reviewed by the Ministry and it is now decided, in continuation of the earlier OM on the subject, that CGHS beneficiaries getting medicines for Chronic diseases shall be permitted to purchase medicines based on the prescription held (prescribed by CGHS Medical Officers/CGHS Specialists /other Govt. Specialists/ Specialist of empaneled hospital) till 31st July, 2021 on the same conditions as per the earlier OM dated 27.03.2020. It is also clarified that the CGHS Wellness Centers are functional and CGHS beneficiaries also have the option to collect medicines through CGHS Wellness Centers as per normal practice, instead of purchasing from market.

4. These orders shall be valid from date of issue till 31st July 2021.

As you are aware, DPE vide OM No W-02 / 0039 / 2017-DPE(WC)-GL-XVI/20 dated 19 11 2020 had decided to freeze the rate of IDA in respect of the Board level and below Board Wye! Executives of all CPSEs w e f 01 10 2020 upto 30 06 2021 at the level prevailing as on 01 07 2020 The same has been implemented in BSNL in respect of all employees including Non-executives vide an OM dated 26 11 2020

2. I would like to bring it to your kind notice that the pay arc allowances of the Non-executives of BSNL are governed by the bipartite wage agreement signed between the BSNL Management and the union M per the last wage revision agreement dated 07 05 2010 the IDA is to be paid as per the rates circulated by the DPE from time-to-time However, DPE has not circulated the re'osed rates w e f 01 10 2020 Due to non-availability of IDA rates circulated by DPE, BSNL is not in a position to the pay the IDA at the revised rates in respect of the Nonexecutives

3. BSNL Staff Unions have been requesting to withdraw the said OM issued by BSNL One of the Staff Unions, namely BSNLEU nas also filed a WP before Hon We High Court of Kerala The Hon We High Court vide an interim order 17 02 2021 had observed that d the members of petitioner union are not failing In the category of executives and non-unionized supervisors covered under DPE OM dated 19 11 2020 respondents shall not deny the benefits of dearness allowance to them However as already stated above BSNL is not in position to take any decision in the matter due to non-circulation of IDA rates w e f 01 10 2020 onwards by DPE, which is a pre-requisite for arlowing IDA increase to non-execut,ves in view of the provisions of wage agreement

4. In view of above, I would like to request you to look into the matter and to arrange for circulating the IDA rates w e f 01 10 2020. 01 01 2021 and 01 04 2021 so as to enable BSNL for taking appropriate decision in the matter

CIRCULAR No.01/2021-PHA

Subject: Policy for provision of Concessional FTTH Connections to Serving / Retired employees of BSNL.

Approval of Management Committee of BSNL is hereby conveyed for Concessional FTTH Connection facility to Serving/Retired Executive as well as Non-Executive Employees in BSNL Area only:

- Concessional FTTH/ Bharat Air Fibre connection may be offered to BSNL serving as well as retired employees subject to 40% concession on plan charges with ceiling of Rs. 300/- per month (For example — a concession of Rs240/- in plan 599, and a concession of Rs300/- in plan 1200). Concession shall be only on Plan and not on any value added service over the plan. FTTH/Air Fibre plan of FMC of 599 or above shall only be available in this concessional scheme.
- In case of MTNL area, the existing guidelines for providing the concessional broadband only (for below JAG level serving employees) would continue.
- In case of concessional FTTH connection, the concession shall be allowed only in plan charges and the concerned employee will require to bear cost/rent of the OLT/modem, activation, installation or any other charges as applicable to an ordinary subscriber, However, no security deposit will be required from serving employees. Retired employees shall be required to deposit prescribed Security Deposit.
- The policy for JAG and above, serving executives may continue as per circular No. 0212018-PHA dated 04.09.2018. However, such employees may take only one FTTH connection i.e either as per order dated 04.09.2018 or under this policy

- with 40% concession limited to Rs 300/-.
- FTTH Connections already working in private capacity or availed under 10% concession scheme (as per CFA Cell Circular R&C-CFA No. 67/20-21 dated 15.01.2021) may be allowed to be migrated to eligible concessional plan if requested by the employee.
- The facility of providing concessional FTTH connection to the spouse of an eligible retired BSNL employee after the death of such employee may not be provided in this policy.
- The provision of FTTH shall be subject to its feasibility.
- Concessional FTTH connection shall be in lieu of (i) the concessional broadband, (ii) existing RSTC/CTC landline connection and (iii) Bharat Fibre services availed under 10% concession scheme (as per CFA Cell Circular R&C-CFA No.67/20-21 dated 15.01.2021) and they will be withdrawn upon provisioning of the FTTH connection under this policy.
- GSM in lieu of RSTC/CTC provided in TNF area as per this office order dated 03.01.2020 shall also be withdrawn after provisioning of FTTH.
- Other terms and conditions shall be governed as per existing Rules and guidelines issued for serving / concessional connection for serving / retired employees.

Subject: On boarding of CGHS empanelled HCOs on NHA IT Platform for paperless Hospital Billing

* * *

CGHS has initiated the process of transitioning of Hospital Billing from UTI-ITSL to National Health Authority (NHA) IT platform to make the entire process smooth and paperless. The hospital bill submission and processing related to CGHS empanelled hospitals and diagnostic centres (also called Health Care Organizations or HCOs) is being implemented through National Health Authority (NHA) IT platform in a phased manner.

1. To achieve the above, all currently empanelled HCOs are required to register themselves with the NHA. The HCOs are required to provide their details on Hospital Empanelment Module (HEM) <https://hospitals.pmjay.gov.in/empApplicationHome.htm?actionVal=loginPage>. On submission of the HCO details on HEM, it shall be forwarded online to the CGHS Additional Director of the city/HQ for approval. Post approval, HCOs shall receive the login for onboarding the Transaction Management System (TMS) [<https://cghs.nha.gov.in/CGHS/loginnew.htm>].

2. As an extension of the existing system for issue of permissions and referral from CGHS Wellness Centres for OPD consultations, listed investigations, listed procedures and follow-up, the system has now been made online and shall be accessed through the TMS, by the HCO where the beneficiary wishes to avail services. Each OPD consultation / investigation / procedure / follow-up or a set of consultations / investigations/procedures/follow-up issued to a beneficiary would be tagged to a system generated unique referral ID. On entering the referral ID in the TMS, the HCO would be able to access the components of the referral ID and the accompanying remarks entered by the doctor in the CGHS Wellness Centre.

3. In case the doctor in the Wellness Centre issues online permission on his / her own, it would be termed as "referral" and in case the doctor issues online permission based on prescription issued by an empanelled hospital specialist, it would be termed as "endorsement".

4. As per existing CGHS guidelines, when the beneficiary visits the empanelled HCO of his/her choice, he/she is expected to produce the following documents: i. the valid CGHS plastic card/Index card/print out of e-CGHS card : it is mandatory to produce any one of these ii. the CGHS issued printout of the referral having the online generated Referral ID or valid prescription(s) from Specialists of Government hospitals or valid prescription issued through eSanjeevani portal (these documents are not required in case of emergencies or in case of beneficiaries of age 75 years and above). In the event of power failure/net connectivity issues at the Wellness Centre, offline endorsement/referral issued by a Wellness Centre shall be accepted by the HCO.

5. In addition, as an initial step, the HCOs would be required to verify the beneficiaries on the NHA platform through the Beneficiary Identification System (BIS) [<https://bis.pmjay.gov.in/BIS/mobileverify>] as a one-time measure, using the CGHS beneficiary ID or Aadhar Card. Beneficiary would be given the option by the HCO to undergo the Aadhaar authentication, as that would ease the delivery of service. Subsequent visit of the beneficiary to any HCO would not require verification on the BIS.

6. The HCOs would be required to book treatment (OPD consultation / investigations/procedures/follow-up/admission) of CGHS pensioner beneficiaries and submit claims on the TMS for reimbursement by CGHS.

7. In case of those empanelled laboratories that are providing Home Collection as a special service, they can submit their claims, along with the following (to be collected by the Home Collection Service personnel either digitally or physically): i. valid CGHS plastic card/print out of e-Index card or paper Index Card/print out of e-CGHS card ii. Copy of online referral print-out issued from CGHS wellness center with Referral ID or valid manual prescription from a government specialist or valid prescription generated through esanjeevani portal Lab Home services need to complete the online BIS process and can proceed with further process of raising the claim.

8. In those cases where the pensioner beneficiary is referred by the CGHS Wellness Centre, he/she would be required to share the referral slip containing the referral ID with the HCO. Only a single print out needs to be generated by the CGHS Wellness Centre for Referral ID(s) generated on a single day by a doctor in the Wellness Centre, even if a beneficiary needs to visit multiple HCOs. The HCO, if required, shall retain a scanned copy of the print out and return the original print out to the beneficiary.

9. The HCO would access the Transaction Management System (TMS) [<https://cghs.nha.gov.in/CGHS/loginnew.htm>] of the NHA and enter the referral ID, to view the components (OPD consultation/investigation/procedure/followup)

advised/endorsed by the CGHS doctor through the Referral Module. The HCO would select the components which the pensioner beneficiary wishes to get done at that HCO and are available in that HCO.

10. If the beneficiary is required to visit another HCO for remaining components of a referral ID, the subsequent HCO(s) would be able to view all the components in the referral ID including those that have been consumed by the previous HCO on TMS. However, the subsequent HCO(s) would be able to consume only those components of the referral ID, that have not been consumed by the previous HCO(s). The details of the status of the referral (consumed or not consumed) would be made available by NHA to the Wellness Centre also.

11. When a beneficiary visits an empanelled hospital for specialist consultation, the specialist would be required to advise the investigations / procedures/further OPD consultation in printed format/ clear legible handwriting, preferably mentioning the CGHS codes (serial number as per the CGHS rate list) to ensure that the doctor in the CGHS Wellness Centre is able to decipher the prescription issued by the empanelled hospital and generate an online "endorsement" through the Referral Module. Beneficiaries of age 75 years and above are not required to visit CGHS Wellness Centres for such "endorsements" for OPD consultations/listed procedures/ listed investigations.

12. For unlisted /unspecified investigations and procedures, advised in OPD, the pensioner beneficiaries (including those of age 75 years and above) would be issued permission by the Additional Director of the city/zone, as per extant CGHS guidelines. This permission issued by the Additional Director needs to be uploaded along with other documents by the HCO at the time of raising an intimation. In admitted beneficiaries, no permission is required to be issued by CGHS authorities.

13. In case of pensioner beneficiaries, ex-MPs, Freedom Fighters, serving beneficiaries of CGHS, DGHS and MoHFW, and such other categories of CGHS beneficiaries who are eligible for credit, the empanelled HCO would be required to extend cashless benefit, while the serving and pensioner beneficiaries belonging to autonomous bodies and serving beneficiaries would claim reimbursement from their Ministry/Department for treatment / investigation / procedure / consultation/follow up availed at the empanelled HCO, as per extant guidelines. Currently the hospital billing through NHA IT Platform is for pensioner beneficiaries only.

14. As per extant guidelines, the following three categories of beneficiaries are not required to visit the CGHS Wellness Centre for issue of permission for OPD consultation /listed investigations/ l i s t e d procedures/followup: i. beneficiaries 75 years of age

and above ii. beneficiaries carrying valid prescription(s) issued by specialists of any Government hospital/Centre iii. beneficiaries carrying valid prescription(s) issued through e-Sanjeevani teleconsultation The HCO would be required to upload such prescriptions in the TMS a n d c a p t u r e online, the details of treatment / investigations / procedures/further consultations advised in such prescriptions. This process shall also be followed by the HCO, in the event of offline endorsement/referral issued by a Wellness Centre due to power failure/net connectivity issues at the Wellness Centre. This information would also be made available in CGHS database by NHA.

15. For any deviation or addition of components by the HCO in the online referral / endorsement from the CGHS Wellness Centre or prescription issued by government hospital specialist (including teleconsultation through eSanjeevani), the beneficiary would be required to visit the CGHS Wellness Centre for online endorsement.

16. Permission from CGHS Wellness Centres is not required for treatment in case of emergencies. Such cases would be auto approved by NHA at the empanelled hospital and treatment would be initiated.

17. The online intimation through TMS, regarding all beneficiaries registered/admitted by 11.59pm on a particular day, would need to be raised by the HCO by 11.59PM of the next day. A relaxation in this timeline would be given to HCOs till 30/06/2021.

18. HCOs shall submit the claim on the NHA TMS online system and same will be processed by a panel of claim processing doctors at NHA and approved for payment by CGHS sanctioning authority through TMS. PFMS system has been integrated with NHA's TMS system for processing the payment directly into the bank account of the HCOs, upon sanction by competent authority.

The provisions of this memorandum come into force on the date of issue.

Subject : Submission of LC / DLC by DoT pensioners (SAMPANN/FMS) at any CCA office.

It has been observed that SAMPANN / IFMS pensioners may face difficulties in submitting their Physical Life Certificates when they reside in a circle other than the circle which issued the PPO which could lead to delays and thereby stoppage of pension. Additionally, in case of Digital Life Certificate (DLC) via Jeevan Pramaan, it has been observed that sometimes the DLC is submitted to a CCA office other than concerned CCA office unknowingly by pensioners and therefore the details are not updated in the system(s).

Therefore. for convenience of pensioners, I am directed to convey the following:

1. DoT pensioners receiving pension via SAMPANN / Financial Management System can submit their Physical Life Certificate in any nearby CCA office. To ensure successful uploading of Life Certificate, the following immediate steps may be taken:
 - a. Recipient CCA should scan the Physical Life Certificate and send the soft copy to the concerned CCA Office via an official email ID.
 - b. Subsequently, recipient CCA should send the hard copy in original by Post as well.
 - c. Concerned CCA Office may update the Life Certificate details based on the soft copy received.
2. For Digital Life Certificate via Jivan Pramaan submitted incorrectly by the pensioner, the following step may be taken:
 - a. The recipient CCA, on identification of the concerned CCA, may share the data immediately with that concerned CCA via an official email ID

Pr. CCA/CCA Offices are requested to inform pensioners and Pensioners Associations via means of letters/SMS/call regarding the above.

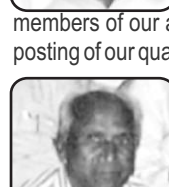

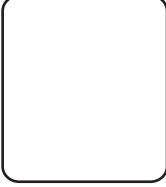

વર્તમાન મહામારીમાં આપણી હાલત

છેલ્લા એક વર્ષથી આપણે સૌ ત્રિશંકુ જેવી હાલતમાં જીવી રહ્યા છીએ, અને વર્તમાન મહામારીનો અંત આવવાની રાહ જોવામાં દિવસો પસાર કરી રહ્યા છીએ. ગયા વર્ષના અંતભાગમાં આશાનું કિરણ દેખાયું હતું, પણ તે છેતરામણું નીકળ્યું. આપણે ફરી પાછા ગયા વર્ષથી પણ વધારે ખરાબ હાલતમાં ધકેલાઈ ગયા.

અમારે ક્યાંય પણ બહાર ગયા વગર ઘરમાં જ ભરાઈ રહેવું પડ્યું અને ઘેરથી જ અમે BSNL પેન્શનરોના હિત માટે કેટલાક સરકારી નિયમોમાં છૂટછાટ મેળવવાની લડત ચલાવે રાખી. લાચારીપૂર્વક નજીકના મિત્રો-સ્વજનોને મહામારીના ખપ્પરમાં હોમાતા જોયે રાખીને આપણે આવી દયાજનક પરિસ્થિતિમાં મહાપરાણે ટકી ગયા છીએ.

હવે પરિસ્થિતિ સાવ બદલાઈ ચૂકી છે. કારણ કે, ભયના તેમજ અનિશ્ચિતતાના ઓછાયા થી ત્રસ્ત નાગરિકો માટે લોકડાઉન ખૂબ ઘાતક સાબિત થાય તેવી ધાસ્તીને કારણે હવે તો સરકાર પણ એવાં આકરાં પગલાં લેવાથી ખચકાઈ રહી છે.

એટલે હવે કોરોના સંકટને હરાવવા માટે આપણે બધાએ સહિયારી જવાબદારી લેવાનું અત્યંત અનિવાર્ય થઈ પડ્યું છે; અન્યથા આનાથી પણ વધુ માઠા પરિણામો ભોગવવાનો વારો આવશે. હવે તો ન્યાયપાલિકાએ પણ કહી દીધું છે કે, સરકારો સાચા આંકડા અને વાસ્તવિકતા છૂપાવી રહી છે; તેથી આપણે સૌએ સાથે મળીને સંકટમાંથી ઉગરવાના પ્રયાસ કરવા ખૂબ જરૂરી છે.

માસ્ક ના પહેરવા બદલ કે સામાજિક અંતર ન જાળવવા માટેના દંડાત્મક પગલાં એ કાંઈ સાચો ઉપાય નથી. જેને આર્થિક રીતે પરવડે

તેમ નથી એવા અમુક કાયદાભીરુ નાગરિકોને જ આવા નિયમોની અસર થાય છે. જ્યાં સુધી પરિસ્થિતિની ગંભીરતા સમજીને તમામ નાગરિકો નિયમપાલન નહીં કરે ત્યાં સુધી, આવા આકરાં જોહુકમીભર્યા નિયમો-ઉપાયો કદાપિ સફળ નહીં થાય. સંકટમાંથી ઉગરવાના સરકારી પ્રયાસોને આપણે સૌએ સાથ-સહકાર આપવો જોઈશે. હાલના સંજોગોને જોતાં પરિસ્થિતિની ગંભીરતા સમજીને આપણે બને ત્યાં સુધી બહાર નીકળવાનું ટાળવું જોઈશે, વારંવાર હાથ ધોવા જોઈશે, સામાજિક અંતર જાળવવું જોઈશે, સેનેટાઈઝેશન કરવું જોઈશે તેમજ ધાર્મિક, સામાજિક કે રાજકીય મેળાવડાઓથી દૂર રહેવું જ જોઈશે.

હવે સિક્કાની બીજી બાજુ જોઈએ તો, પૂરતાં સૈન્ય અને શસ્ત્ર સરંજામ વગર કોઈપણ જંગ જીતવો અશક્ય છે તેજ પ્રમાણે જો સરકાર નાગરિકો પાસેથી નિયમપાલનની અપેક્ષા રાખતી હોય તો, તેણે પોતાના નાગરિકોને આર્થિક રીતે જરૂરી અનાજ અને દવાઓ ખરીદી શકે એટલા સધ્ધર રાખવાનું પણ ધ્યાન રાખવું પડશે. ભૂખ્યા પેટે ભજન ના થઈ શકે, રોજેરોજનું કમાઈ લાવીને પરિવારનું પેટ ભરતાં નાગરિકોની પાસેથી ઘરમાં બેસી રહેવાની અપેક્ષા રાખવી નકામી છે. પૂરતો કામઘંઘો ન હોવાના કારણે કેટલાય સરકારી અને ખાનગી સંસ્થાનોએ કેટલાય નોકરિયાતોને છૂટા કરી દીધા છે. ઘરેથી કામ કરવાની છૂટ ધરાવતા કર્મચારીઓની જવાબદારી અને ખર્ચા પણ વધી ગયા છે. છતાંયે આવા નાગરિકોના પગાર અને ભથ્થા ઘટાડી દેવાયા છે, એ ખૂબ નવાઈની વાત છે. સરકારની અપીલને માન આપીને પ્રજાએ ઉદાર હાથે ફાળો આપીને રાહતભંડોળ છલકાવી દીધું છે. કેટલાક જાહેર અને ખાનગી મોટા ઉદ્યોગોએ જરૂરતમંદોને અનાજ-કપડાં પૂરાં પાડવાની જવાબદારી ઉઠાવી લીધી છે.

BSNL પેન્શનરોની વાત કરીએ તો, જીવનના અમુલ્ય પાંત્રીસેક વર્ષો સરકારી સેવામાં વિતાવી દેનારા વરિષ્ઠ નાગરિકોને

મદદરૂપ થવાનો અત્યારે સરકારનો ખરેખરો સમય છે. લગભગ ત્રણ વર્ષથી નહીં ચૂકવાયેલા મેડિકલ ભથ્થા તેમજ ઈન્ડોર અને આઉટડોર સારવારના બીલોની ચૂકવણી માટે સરકાર જરૂરી ફંડ તરત જ છૂટું કરે એની આપણે રાહ જોઈએ છીએ. પોતાના વર્તમાન કર્મચારીઓનું તો BSNL ધ્યાન રાખે છે અને તેમના પગાર-ભથ્થાં સમયસર ચૂકવી આપે છે. પરંતુ નિવૃત્ત પેન્શનરોને બોજારૂપ ગણીને, જાણે તેમને ફરિયાદ કરાવનો કોઈ અધિકાર જ ના હોય તેમ, એમને હડધૂત કરવાનું વલણ BSNL ધરાવે છે. એવું સ્પષ્ટ દેખાઈ આવે છે. સરકાર BSNL પેન્શનરોની પડતર બાબતો પર પૂનર્વિચાર કરી આપણા બાકીના ચૂકવણા વહેલાસર ચૂકવી આપે એવી અમારી તીવ્ર લાગણી છે.

હાલમાં સેવારત કર્મચારીઓને વાર્ષિક ઈજાફો અને અન્ય ભથ્થાં સમયસર ચૂકવાય છે. પરંતુ પેન્શનરોની મોંઘવારી ભથ્થાને રાષ્ટ્રીય સંકટના બહાને તા. ૩૦ જૂન ૨૦૨૧ સુધી સ્થગિત કરી દેવાયું છે. VRS-2019 યોજના થકી BSNL કર્મચારીઓનું પગારબીલ ખાસ્તું ઘટી ગયું હોવાં છતાંયે; દયાજનક રીતે આર્થિક હાલત એના પ્રમાણમાં સુધરી નથી. BSNL પેન્શનરો; પોતાના મેડિકલ બીલો ત્રણ ત્રણ વરસથી ચૂકવાયા નથી તે સંજોગોમાં; ભવિષ્યમાં મોટી લાંબી બિમારી વખતે પોતાનું શું થશે ? એની ચિંતામાં; પોતાના પેન્શનમાંથી મસમોટી દાખલ ફી ભરીને CGHS માં જોડાઈ રહ્યા છે.

હવે જ્યારે, DoT ના વલણ મુજબ સેવારત કર્મચારીઓનો તા. ૦૧-૦૧-૨૦૧૭ થી થવાપાત્ર વધારો નજીકમાં થાય એવું લાગતું નથી. ત્યારે, ભૂતકાળમાં અપાયેલ છે એ પ્રમાણે, તા. ૦૧-૦૧-૨૦૧૭ થી ૧૧૮.૫% IDA ને પેન્શનમાં ભેળવીને (સંપૂર્ણ તટસ્થીકરણ) આર્થિક લાભ હાલ પણ BSNL પેન્શનરોને આપવા માટે અમે સરકારને વિનંતી કરીએ છીએ.

કેન્દ્ર સરકારના અન્ય પેન્શનર સંગઠનોની માફક BDPA પણ પેન્શનરોની સેવા કરે છે અને આપણું પેન્શન કેન્દ્રીય ભંડોળમાંથી જ મળે છે એટલે આપણે પૂરેપૂરા હકદાર પણ છીએ; તેમ છતાંયે પેન્શનર કલ્યાણ મંત્રાલય (DO PPW) દ્વારા આપણને કોઈ આર્થિક સહાય અપાતી નથી. જો પેન્શનર કલ્યાણ મંત્રાલય (DO PPW) તરફથી આર્થિક સહાય મળે તો, પેન્શનરોને ઘેરબેઠા હયાતિના પ્રમાણપત (DLC)ની સગવડ ઉપલબ્ધ કરાવીને અમે તેમની સારી સેવા વધુ સારી રીતે કરી શકીએ તેમ છીએ.

अप्रैल-2021 के तंत्रीलेख का हिन्दी अनुवाद

वर्तमान महामारी में हमारी हालत

पिछले एक सालसे हम सब त्रिशंकु जैसे हालात में जी रहे है और वर्तमान महामारी ख़तम होने का इंतजार में दिन गुज़ार रहे हैं, पिछले साल के अंतभागमें आशा किरण दिखाई दी थी, मगर मगर वो भी छलावा निकली। हम सब पिछले सालसे भी बदतर हालातमें धकेले गये।

हमें कहीं भी बाहर निकलना टाल के घर ही में बन्द रहना पडा और BSNL पेंशनरों के लाभ में कुछएक सरकारी नियमोंमें छूट दिलाने की लडाईं घरबैठे ही जारी रखनी पडी। अपने करीबी रिश्तेदारों या स्वजनों को लाचारीपूर्वक महामारी के बलि चढते देखते हुए ऐसे करुण हालात में भी हम जैसे तैसे टिक गये हैं।

लेकिन अब परिस्थिति गंभीर करवट बदल चुकी है, क्योंकि; डर तथा असमंजस-दूविधा से त्रस्त नागरिकों पर लॉकडाउन ख़तरनाक साबित होने की आशंका से, अब तो सरकार भी ऐसे कठोर कदम उठाने से झिझक रही है।

इसलिये, अब कोरोना संकट से उबरने के लिये मिलझूल कर जिम्मेवारी उठाना, हमारे लिये ख़ूब जरूरी हो गया है। अन्यथा इससे भी बदतर परिणाम भोगने पडेंगे। अब तो न्यायपालिकाने भी कह दिया है कि - सरकार सच्चे आंकडे तथा हकीकतों को छूपा रही है। इसलिये हम सबको एकजूट होकर इस महासंकट से उबरने का प्रयास करना अत्यंत अनिवार्य हो गया है।

मास्क ना पहनने या सामाजिक दूरी का पालन ना करने के लिये जूरमाना वूसलना - ये सही उपाय नहीं है। जिसे आर्थिक रूपमें खलता है ऐसे चंद नियमपालक नागरिक ही ऐसे दण्डात्मक

नियमोंके दायरे में आते हैं। जब तक तमाम नागरिक हालात की नज़ाकत को समझकर नियमपालन नहीं करते तबतक; ऐसे कठोर नियम कदापि सफल नहीं हो पाएंगे। संकट से उबरने के सरकारी प्रयासमें हम सबको साथ-सहकार देना ही पडेगा। वर्तमान परिस्थिति को ध्यान में रखते हुए, उसकी गंभीरता को समझकर हमें; संभव हो वहा तक बाहर निकलना टालना होगा, बारबार हाथों को धोना होगा, सॅनेटाइज़ेशन करना होगा, सामाजिक दूरी बरतनी होगी तथा धार्मिक, सामाजिक या राजनैतिक सभाओंसे दूर रहना ही होगा।

अब सिक्क के दूसरे पहलू को देखें तो, कोई भी जंग जरूरी सेना तथा हथियारों के बिना जीता नहीं जा सकता। इसी तरह नागरिकों से नियमपालन की अपेक्षा रखती सरकार को अपने नागरिकों को पर्याप्त राशन तथा दवाइयाँ ख़रीद सके इतने आर्थिकरूप से सक्षम रखने का भी ध्यान देना पडेगा। भूखे पेट भजन नहीं होय गोपाला। रोजबरोज की कमाई लाकर मुश्किल से अपने परिवार का पेट पालने वाले नागरिकों से घर में ही बन्द रहने की अपेक्षा रखना बिलकुल व्यर्थ है। पूरा कारोबार ठीकठाक ना चलने की वजह से कई सरकारी तथा निजी संस्थानोंने कितने ही नोकरीपेशा कर्मचारीयों को रुखसत दे दी है। घर से ही काम करने की छूट वाले कर्मचारीयों की जिम्मेवारी तथा दैनिक खर्च भी बढ़ गये हैं। इसके बावजूद भी ऐसे कर्मचारीयों के वेतन तथा भत्ते घटाये गये हैं; ये बडे आश्चर्य की बात है! सरकारी अपीलों को सम्मान दे कर प्रजाने उदार हाथों से राहतकोष को छलका दिया है। जाहिर तथा निजी क्षेत्र के कई बडे उद्योगगृहोंने जरूरतमंदों को राशन-कपडे-दवाइयाँ आदि पहुंचाने की जिम्मेवारी अपने कांधों पे उठा ली है।

जहाँ तक BSNL पेन्शनभोगीयों की बात है; पैंतीस जितने अमुल्य साल सरकारी सेवामें बिता चूके वरिष्ठ नागरिक को सही अर्थमें सहायरूप होनेका, फ़िलहाल सरकारके लिये, ये सही समय है। करीब तीन साल से बकाया हमारे चिकित्सा भत्ता तथा ईनडॉर एवम् आउटडॉर चिकित्सा बीलों क भूगतान के वास्ते आवश्यक धनराशि सरकार त्वरित आर्बंटित करें; उसका हमें बेसब्रीसे इंतज़ार है। BSNL अपने वर्तमान सेवारत कर्मचारीयों के वेतन तथा चिकित्साबील चूकाने का तो पूरा ध्यान रखता है मगर; निवृत्त पेन्शनभोगीयों को बोझ मानते हुए, जैसे की उन्हें फरियाद तक करने का कोइ अधिकार ही ना हो ऐंसे; BSNL ने उन्हें हर मामले में लटकाये रखने का रवैया अपना रक्खा है, ऐसा स्पष्टदिख रहा है। पेन्शनभोगीयों की बकाया मांगों पर पुनर्विचार करके उनकी बकाया रकम BSNL समय से भूगतान कर दे, ऐसा हम चाहते हैं।

वर्तमान सेवारत कर्मचारीयों क वेतन, वार्षिक ईजाफे अन्य भत्ते ठीक समय पर चूकाये जाते हैं। किन्तु पेन्शनभोगीयों के महँगाइ भत्ते को दि. 30-6-2021 तक स्थगित किया गया है। VRS-2019 योजना अंतर्गत BSNL के वेतन बीलको काफी घटाये जाने क बाद भी, उसकी आर्थिक स्थिति में दयाजनक रीतसे उसके अनुपात में सुधार नहीं हो पाया है। अपने चिकित्सा बील तीन तीन साल तक नहीं मीलने के बाद, भविष्य में कोई लंबी या बड़ी बिमारी आने पर अपना क्या होगा ? इसकी चिंता के कारण; अधिकतर पेन्शनभोगी अपनी पेन्शनमें से अच्छा खासा तग़डा प्रवेश शुल्क चूका कर CGHS में तबदील हो रहे हैं।

अब जब; DOT के हाल के रवैये के मुताबिक दि. 01-01-2017 से होनेवाला सेवारत कर्मचारीयोंका वेतन संशोधन नदजीक में हो पाने के कुछ आसार दिखाई नहीं देते है। तब,

दि. 01-01-2017 से 119.5% IDA को पेन्शनमें मिलाकर (संपूर्ण तटस्थकरण) जो कि, पहले दिया जा चूका है, ऐसा लाभ हालमें भी BSNL पेन्शनभोगीयों को दिया जाए, ऐसी हम सरकार को बिनती करते हैं।

केद्र सरकार के अन्य पेन्शनर संगठनों की भांति BDPA संगठन भी BSNL पेन्शनभोगीयों की सेवा करता है; तथा हमारी पेन्शनभी केन्द्रीय धनराशि से ही मिल रही है इसलिये हम न्यायिक रूप से हक़दार भी है; इसके बावजूद भी पेन्शन कल्याण मंत्रालय (DOPPW) से हमें कोई आर्थिक सहाय नहीं दी जाती। अगर DOPPW की तरफ से हमें ऐसी आर्थिक मदद मिल पाये तो हम पेन्शनभोगीयों को हयाति प्रमाणपत्र (DLC) की सुविधा घर बैठे ही उपलब्ध करवा के उनकी बहेतर सेवा और भी अच्छी तरह से कर पाएंगे, ऐसा हमारा विश्वास है।
