Respected Sir,

1. We enclose herewith a copy of our letter of even No. dated 13.09.2021 addressed to you and forwarded by Speed Post.
2. On the basis of our letter we were expected to have final issuance of Vigilance Certificate by the Administration, we have been able to satisfy the administration that it has been wrongly withheld and no action have been taken though repeatedly requested by the Pensioner.
3. When the District Secretary Valsad District took up the case with your office, he was unconstitutionally harassed and asked to submit many unwarranted information.
4. Sir, so we had no option but to interfere and invite your attention in detail justifying the fact that it is willful act of withholding issuance of Vigilance Certificate by the Valsad GMTD.
5. On the basis of our letter, Valsad GMTD realizing his error at his end, not pressed for submission of required documents by the District Secretary Valsad and closed the case.
6. Sir, we are sorry to say that though more than three months period is over, no further action to release Vigilance Certificate of Class III employee has been taken.
7. We therefore, earnestly request you to kindly intervene and on the basis justification submitted with required documents; and cause early clearance of the Pensioner's case.

We conclude this letter with hope and expectations that your office will have positive outlook on our say and save the pensioner from his agony and financial distress since last eleven years.
