Subject: A request to re-examine and issue orders conferring TSM Status & consequential P.O.– Sanction Provisional Pension – Case of Sadhu Charan Kerai, ATT.

Respected Sir,

1. It has been brought to our notice; while going through a letter No: BSNLCO-A/13(16)/4/2020-ESTE dated 14.10.022 addressed to your office by the Corporate Office (copy enclosed) that your office was informed that your letter for issuing Presidential Order in respect of left out casual labourers who have been conferred TSM status on or before 30.09.2022 and regularized on or after 01.10.2000 could not withstood for scrutiny; and therefore it was rejected.
2. Shri Sadhu Charan Kerai, was retired on 30.09.2019 as ATT and was as per your records was eligible for Pension, Gratuity and other pensionery benefits.
3. As we understand, the Pensioner was conferred TSM Status as per directives of CAT Patna; after examining his eligibility as he had already completed 240 days of continuous service vide your office order dated 05.06.1996.
4. Your office was duty bound to forward the case in July 1996 to Corporate Office for issuing Presidential orders on regularizing services of the Pensioners.
5. Since 8 months period is over from receipt of corporate office letter, we request to send the case to the corporate office with due justification for issue of presidential orders as all services rendered by the pensioners is also checked and confirmed by auditors as well.
6. Till this is done, the Pensioner may be issued provisional pension and also provisional gratuity as admissible.
