Subject: Non-supply of link for Virtually National Pension Adalat held on 17.05.2023 &  
Non-Receipt of Minutes of previous National Pension Adalat held on 29.03.2023.

Respected Madam,

1. The previous National Pension Adalat was held on 29.03.2023 and the District Secretary of Valsad District had participated physically and the undersigned virtually on line.
2. The issues of S/Shri S.P. Contractor, M.D. Chaudhari and M.G. Patel were discussed in the meeting where all the concerned pensioners were also present with D.S. All the cases are pending since long and it has become punishment for these pensioners as the Administration is not taking due interest and care of these pensioners.
3. If your office feels that the office of the CGM Gujarat is not cooperative, then the matter ought to have been brought to the notice of Secretary DoT/CMD BSNL. Keeping silence and to give long rope to the office of the CGM indirectly reflects upon the functioning of Pension Adalat and make it mockery of the system.
4. We regret to write that the minutes of the said Pension Adalat are not published and second National Pension Adalat was held on 17.05.2023.
5. We have membership of 7761 from Gujarat Circle and that is the largest figure any Pensioners Association in Gujarat is holding.
6. We were informed that for virtual presence a link will be provided to us and we were kept waiting till completion of the Pension Adalat. This gave a shabby picture of our functioning before our Surat District Secretary and his team – who were physically present in the Adalat and were anxious to watch role of the Circle.

7. We drawn the attention of high profile officers of your office to get the link but unfortunately our say was not heard. Copies of conversation are enclosed herewith.
8. Merely saying to say that “sorry sir... just missed to send” will not help the Association.

We, therefore, request your august office to:

1. Supply minutes of the Pension Adalat dated 29.03.2023 & 17.05.2023.
2. To give us latest position on SAMPANN for the Pensioners of Post Offices and guide us for your future road-map.
3. If the Pensioners Identity Cards are ready, then as proposed by our District Secretary, Surat to send them Surat Pensioners Card instead of sending them by post as your proposal to send by ordinary post will result in large complaints of non-receipt as now a day’s post offices are not delivering ordinary posts and the department can not afford the expenditure of Regd. Post.
4. We specially request you to kindly personally examine case of Shri M.G. Patel, whose case is pending since 2010 for no fault of the Pensioner.
