**Subject: A request to retain C.C.A. Office in Telephone Exchange
Kavadiguda Secunderabad.**

Respected Sir,

1. It has been brought to our notice that Pr. C.C.A. Office which is presently placed at Kavadiguda / Chikkadpally Hyderabad is proposed to be shifted to Telephone Exchange Kukatpally on administrative reasons.
2. Had it been only administrative office we would have not mind it's shifting; as it is prerogative of the administration.
3. In fact, the present situated office, BSNL & DoT pensioners are used to visit frequently for their pension related issues and it is easily reachable.
4. The proposal - as we understand – is to shift it to Telephone Exchange Kukatpally Hyderabad; which is in remote corner of the Hyderabad City; which will cause lot of inconvenience to the aged Pensioners to represent their grievances, who are residing at other corners of the city/ Districts.
5. The Telephone Exchange Kukatpally Hyderabad is placed at far away from City Bus stop / Metro-station Stop i.e. JNTU Stop and the aged pensioners, who are residing at other corners of the City / District have to change minimum of 3 to 4 busses to reach Main bus stop of Kukatpally HB (i.e. JNTU) as there is no direct route to the said office; causing mental strain, expenditure and time.
6. We therefore urge you to kindly consider our request not to shift the office from the present place on humanitarian grounds respecting sentiments of aged pensioners.

However, if it is quite inevitable to shift it from present place, we request to kindly consider our proposal to shift it to B S Bhavan, Adarshnagar, Near Burugula Ramakrishna Building Hyderabad OR Telephone Bhavan Lakdikapool, Hyderabad OR Door Sanchar Bhavan, Abids, Hyderabad OR CTO Building, Near Paradise Circle, Secunderabad, since all are centrally located in the city having high frequency of Public Transport such as City Busses / Metro trains. Further, the proposed places will also be convenient to the Pensioners of Other Districts and members of staff.

During our visit to Hyderabad on 26.07.2023, the issue was also discussed with Joint C.C.A. Telangana Circle, **Shri C.M. Sampar** by S/Shri D.D. Mistry, D. Chandrasekharan & T. Karuna Prasad CS Telangana Circle.

This will be more convenient and comfortable for aged pensioners of the City and also the Pensioners of the District.
