Sub: A request to accord your approval for sanction for long pending Covid-19 cases of Ahmedabad Telecom District, Ahmedabad.

Respected Sir,

1. We are thankful to your for holding Medical Adalat on 25.03.2023, wherein total 161 cases were received by the Circle Office through email. Out of these, 16 were already paid, 11 were processed/approved and waiting for fund, 24 cases were under process.
2. In the meeting, first issue of pending Covid-19 cases was discussed and it was decided by your honour that all Covid-19 cases will be treated as Emergent cases, as per BSNLMRS guidelines dated 28.02.2003/23.08.2006 treating them under indoor medical treatment under emergency in non-empanelled Hospital as per CGHS Rates.
3. We are happy to write that a long pending case of Corona period 13.02.21 to 24.2.21 of Shri Jayantibhai Z. Patel, retired Sr. TOA(G), under o/o the PGM Vadodara Telecom District is settled and he has been paid Rs.3,50,000 appx.
4. We are also happy to state that with your positive outlook, many cases of Corona were settled who were present in the Adalat.
5. Sir, from Ahmedabad Telecom District, we have received the representations that their cases are still pending and despite their frequent reminder/visits, they could not get any satisfactory reply. We furnish herewith the details of such cases received by us with a request that your office will finalize the cases at the earliest.

- A. First case is of Shri Dashrathbhai H. Prajapati : Retired T.T. H.R. No: 198317489, o/o PGM ATD Ahmedabad. He was admitted in Hospital for the treatment of Covid-19 for hospitalization to Chandra-Mani Hospital, Girdharnagar, Shahibag, Ahmedabad as Indoor Patient from 23.08.2020 to 31.08.2020 FOR Covid-19 treatment. He has submitted his claim for Rs.1,40,000.00 only.
- B. Second Case of Shri A.M. Makwana, retired CSS, HR No; 80073193, A.T.D. Ahmedabad : He was admitted in AASHKA HOSPITALS LTD. Gandhinagar on 01.12.2020 and discharged on 07.12.2020. He was treated for Covid Positive and has submitted his claim to the o/o the Pr. GM Ahmedabad on 02.02.2021 under clear receipt for Rs. 1,96,616.00 only.

When the Pensioner Shri A.M. Makwana, approached your office, he was informed that the cases of those who were present in the Adalat are considered; whereas approaching to the o/o PGM ATD, he is informed that the case is approved and pending for want of fund.

Since the pensioners have submitted their claims and waiting for the sanction of their claims considering it as emergent cases and sanction as per CGHS Rates, we request you to kindly cause early sanction of these cases. All the two pensioners have now reverted to CGHS and so this will be their last case to be settled by your office.

Kindly do needful at the earliest.
