OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Subject:- Disciplinary proceedings in respect of CPSEs employees after superannuation - Updated Model CDA Rule 25(20-a).


The issue of handling disciplinary proceedings after superannuation has been a subject matter of reference from various Ministries and Departments of CPSEs. To address this, the Central Vigilance Commission (CVC) established an Inter-Departmental Committee on 31.01.2024, to examine the issue and give recommendations in this regard. The committee gave its recommendations on 01.07.2024 and the same are under consideration. One of the recommendations of the committee is as under:

“Vigilance cases wherein Charged Officers are retiring soon, disciplinary proceedings should be completed on priority, preferably before retirement or maximum within 6 months of retirement.”

2. In view of above and with the approval of the Competent Authority it has been decided to update DPE Model CDA Rule 25 (20) (a) issued vide DPE OM 15(07)/99-DPE-GM-Vol-III-FTS-2344 dated December 11, 2017 as follows:

25 (20) (a) The Inquiring Authority should conclude the inquiry and submit report within a period of six months from the date of receipt of order of his/her appointment as Inquiring Authority. In vigilance cases wherein Charged Officers are retiring soon, disciplinary proceedings should be completed on priority, preferably before retirement or maximum within 6 months of retirement.

3. All the administrative Ministries / Departments of CPSEs are requested to take note of the above and advise their respective CPSEs to do needful in this regard.
