As we continue to work tirelessly for the welfare of our pensioner community, it has become essential to ensure the smooth functioning of our office; after shifting into our own Office in Ahmedabad and endless expectation from our members.

At present, C.H.Q. Office is functioning regularly for five days from Monday to Friday and five office bearers are providing regular voluntary service for smooth working.

Formerly we were functioning from Central Telegraph Office, Ahmedabad sharing accommodation with FNTO; where we had to incur negligible expenditure towards Office Maintenance. However, since the Administration was taking care of office, we had to incur some expenditure which was within our reach.

In corona time, all the premises was closed for indefinite time and also it was not advisable to continue our functioning from the said premises and we had to purchase our own Office; spending sizable funds. *From 2nd October, 2020, we are functioning from our own office*; which is visited by majority of CHQ Office bearers and other Circle/District Office Bearers.

To maintain our office, we have to incur expenditure towards the following payments:

- ➤ Addressing the District/Circle Conferences
- Participating in yearly AGMs of Bharat Pensioner Samaj & AIFPA Chennai
- Ensuring our office remains accessible and comfortable for all members
- ➤ Office Supplies and Equipment: Maintaining necessary infrastructure for efficient operations
- Miscellaneous Expenses: Covering unexpected expenses to keep our office running smoothly
- ➤ Enhance Office Efficiency: Ensuring prompt response to member queries and requests
- ➤ Support Association Activities: Facilitating organization of events, meetings, and welfare initiatives
- > Strengthen Member Services: Allowing us to provide better support and services to our members
- Maintenance of web, which has monthly viewership of more than 2, 50,000
- Maintenance of Computers, Printer, A/C, Freeze, Aqua guard etc.
- > Regular cleaning of office
- ➤ Paying Affiliation Fees to BPS/AIPFA
- ➤ Postal Expenditure for general issues and also individual cases

We have reviewed our financial situation in the 4th AIC held in Kanyakumari. It was decided to make fervent appeal to members to contribute Rs.365/ by members on his birthday by saving only rupee one per day for the association towards "Office Maintenance Fund."

As the response was very poor, the issue was discussed in 9th Central Working Committee Meeting of BSNL & DOT Pensioners Association (India), held on 10th & 11th August, 2024 in Kurukshetra (Haryana); proposing to collect Rs100/- per member per year towards Office Maintenance Fund. However, it was suggested by the C/S Kurukshetra to continue the same system and all had agreed to.

We regret to write that thereafter, we have started to supply the names of the Pensioners whose birthday falls in particular with a request to collect Rs.100/- by the Circle/District Secretary towards Office Maintenance Fund. The response from Rajkot & Vadodara is good. The Circle Secretary, Haryana Circle is also collecting the donation regularly from the willing members. The Kerala Circle has also responded positively.

For the information of all the office bearers of District/Circle & CHQ, we would like to inform you that Shri Chandrasinh J, Chaudhary, CSS, Membership No: 184;who retired from C.T.O. Surat is from the day he joined the association is contributing Rs.500/- per month since January 2020 regularly. Prior to that date; he was contributing Rs.200/ per quarter; has donated approximately more than 50,000 so far. Late Shri M.P. Tankaria, M.
