Nine years ago we lost our dear and near Shri Pravinbhai Shah, founder member of BDPA (INDIA) and guided us to take it to its highest peak.



Shri P.R. Shah (Pravinbhai Ramanshal Shah), expired on 17.07.2010 at 13.30 hours. In the morning when Shri A.K. Patel & D.D. Mistry paid visit to his house he was unconscious and can not sense anything.

He was born on 17.08.1936 and retired from Central Telegraph Office, Ahmedabad as Sr.S.S. from Establishment Section on superannuation on 31.08.1994. His ensing birth date was falling on 17.08.2010, just after one month from to-day, He

could not complete 74 years as his end came one month prior to that date. He had completed fifteen years period after service to restore his original pension recently.

He had work as Indoor Secretary in Telegraph Recreation Club, as Asstt. Secretary in Telegraph Credit Society and as Circle President in ATTMEU Gujarat Circle during his service period.

He was one of the pioneer members of BDPA Gujarat and instrumental in its formation and providing necessary guidance. He was Vice President of BDPA till his end came. Though he was eager to attend 3rd Gujarat Circle Conference on 29.06.2010 he could not remain present due to his ill health and conveyed his best wishes for success from his bed.
