

Meeting with Shri Vijay Kumar, CCA Gujarat

On 05.01.2026, S/Shri A.N. Patel, D.D. Mistry & R.C. Sharma met Shri Vijay Kumar, CCA Gujarat in his office to greet him on the new year eve and exchanged pleasantries. The following issues were also discussed.

1. Case of request for migration to SAMPANN by Family Pensioner Mrs. Kusumben Rajnikant Mahadik, holder of PPO No. TAC/FP/RBM/99-2---/1-8:

The issue was discussed threadbare and we were informed that the necessary action for getting closure report from the Manager, Bank of India R. V. Desai Road Vadodara has been sought for and also simultaneously the CPPC Nagpur is also addressed to expedite the issue.

The applicant is Mrs. Kusumben Rajnikant Mahadik, wife of late Shri Rajnikant B. Mahadik, Ex-RM serving in the office of SDE (Internal), Makarpura, VADODARA under the PGM Telecom District Vadodara, who expired in while in service on 27.01.1999.

The PPO No. TAC/FP/RBM/99-2---/1-8 was issued by the head of the Office, Vadodara and Bank of India R. V. Desai Road Vadodara was drawing her pension under account No: 250310100020645 IFSC BKID0002503 up to November, 2024 as the bank was accepting her DLC by personal identification of the Family Pension.

When she approached the bank in November, 2025 for her DLC, she was informed by the Bank Manager that she should submit her DLC to her PDA, i.e. CCA Gujarat under SAMPANN.

So, the Family Pensioner generated her TWO DLCs, ONE under PDA as Bank of India and Second as PDA CCA Gujarat.

The CCA Gujarat accepted her DLC and her Family Pension is continued. But now the real issue which came to light on her application for allotting SAMPANN PPO No. is - it is revealed that the Family Pensioner is not in the official record of drawing pension by the CCA Gujarat and her pension is drawn and disbursed by the Bank as Railway Pensioner as per Bank Records!

So, on receiving closure report from the Bank, she will be allotted SAMPANN PPO number and her pension will be henceforth will be drawn by the CCA Gujarat.

We were assured of expediting the issue at their level to avoid hardship to the Family Pensioner.

2. We also discussed regarding pending cases of Notional Increment and we were assured that the issue is handled expeditiously and within short time all the eligible cases will be settled.

3. During the discussion, the CCA impressed upon the novel initiative to help and assist the pensioners by introducing “PENSION SAMVAD” in which the Pensioners are invited to represent the grievance on second Tuesday of the month and he/she is heard in person either in office or on line, where all concerned officials/officers are present and settled the issue. He asked us to inform the pensioners to take full advantage of the system so that there will be no case left for Pension Adalat and there will be healthy relationship with the pensioners and the office.

We are thankful to Shri Vijay Kumar, CCA and his energetic and enthusiastic team to always help the pensioners.
