Sub: A request for judicious and need based sharing of space between the office of the Pr. C.C.A. & Telecom Regulatory Authority of India (TRAI) offices in Telegraph Office, Ethiraj Salai (Road), in Egmore, Chennai

Respected Sir,

1. We are enclosing herewith a copy of letter No: BDPA(I)/TN/GENL dated 19.02.2026 addressed to you by All India Executive President, BDPA (I) on the captioned subject, which is clear and requires examination.
2. As mentioned in the said Telegraph Office, there are Seven Floors and one is utilized for Inspection Quarters.
3. Telecom Regulatory Authority of India (TRAI) office, with a staff of 20 Personnels is housed in the same building..
4. The office of the Pr. C.C.A. Chennai is also housed in the same building which has **staff of 100** personnels and has to store Service Book and other important record of about fifty thousand pensioners.
5. Consequent upon abolition of Civil Wing Office, for sharing of vacant office in a meeting between CCA & TERM, it was decided to share it 50:50
6. Sir, we have just, genuine and realistic feeling that the sharing is not done based upon the actual requirement of these two Offices.

7. In the CCA Office, Pensioners are visiting for generating their DLC, making pension related queries and have to stand under the shadow of trees and the platform of roadside in and around the compound wall.
8. Furthermore, preservation of records i.e. SB Pension file etc. required to be handle with care and to be kept in intact without damaging; as it is a must in view of the pension rules are changing from time to time making eligible for the family members for Family pension, on the demise of pensioner or Family Pensioner. As an example, a model case of Selvi. D. Shirley in Hyderabad Telephone District is pending for the past 18 years for want of original records such as SB, Pension file, pay bill etc., not traceable. Therefore, further shifting of records here and there will damage it in due course.
9. Suitable arrangement for the Pensioners visiting is required to be made as per the instructions of the CGCA and they are to be taken care of for which sufficient space is required.
10. We solicit your favor to kindly examine the space sharing issue on need based requirements with jurisdiction.

we request to kindly cause issue of necessary instructions / guidelines to the Authorities concerned to re-allocate the available space judiciously commensurate to the need and requirement of CCA office taking into account the interest of the pensioners and Family pensioners
