**Sub: Final request for implementation of the Hon'ble CAT Ahmedabad
Judgment in O.A. No. 348/2017 dated 05.03.2026 – Reg.**

Ref:

Respected Sir,

1. Kindly refer to our above-mentioned representations requesting implementation of the judgment delivered by the Hon'ble Central Administrative Tribunal, Ahmedabad Bench, in **O.A. No.348/2017 dated 05.03.2026**, whereby the applicants were held entitled to consequential pensionary benefits arising out of grant of one additional increment.
2. We appreciate that your office has already taken up the matter with the higher authorities for obtaining necessary guidance/approval. However, despite the lapse of considerable time, the judgment still remains unimplemented, causing serious hardship to the applicants, most of whom are senior citizens. Some of the applicants have unfortunately passed away during the pendency of the litigation and their family pensioners are also awaiting the legitimate benefits.
3. We respectfully invite your kind attention to **Paragraph 10** of the judgment, wherein the Hon'ble Tribunal has categorically observed that the issue involved is "**not res integra.**" The Tribunal has specifically relied upon the earlier judgments of the Hon'ble CAT Ernakulam, Chandigarh and Madras Benches and has accepted the claim of the applicants after considering the stand of the respondents. Thus, the legal position now stands well settled.
4. It is also pertinent to mention that the judgments on the same issue have already been implemented in other BSNL Telecom Circles. Therefore, there appears to be no legal or administrative impediment in extending identical relief to the successful applicants in Ahmedabad Telecom District in compliance with the judicial directions.

5. We understand that the period allowed for implementation of the Hon'ble CAT's judgment is shortly coming to an end. In the event of continued non-compliance, the applicants may be constrained to seek appropriate relief by initiating **Contempt Proceedings** before the Hon'ble CAT, Ahmedabad. We sincerely wish to avoid such a situation, which would result in avoidable litigation and unnecessary expenditure of public time and resources.

We, therefore, earnestly request your august office to kindly **pursue the matter on priority with the competent authorities** and also recommend immediate implementation of the Hon'ble CAT judgment so that the applicants receive the benefits already adjudicated in their favour within the prescribed period.

We shall be grateful for your kind and expeditious intervention in the matter.
