Respected Sir,

We respectfully invite your kind attention to the above correspondence regarding implementation of the judgment delivered by the Hon'ble Central Administrative Tribunal, Ahmedabad in O.A. No. 348/2017 on 05.03.2026 in favour of the applicants.

We are thankful for the action already initiated by the BSNL authorities. From the communication received from the office of the PGM (Admin-Legal), Ahmedabad, it is understood that the certified copy of the judgment was received through the learned Advocate, the proposal was promptly processed by the Ahmedabad Telecom District, forwarded by the Gujarat Telecom Circle to the BSNL Corporate Office, and thereafter referred to the Department of Telecommunications for an appropriate decision. These steps reflect the seriousness with which the matter has been dealt with.

However, despite the completion of these procedural stages, the beneficiaries are still awaiting the implementation of the judgment. Most of them are senior citizens, while some are family pensioners, who have already undergone prolonged litigation before obtaining the favourable verdict of the Hon'ble Tribunal. Every further delay naturally causes anxiety and hardship to them.

Our Association has consciously adopted a patient and constructive approach throughout. Although the applicants are legally entitled to pursue further judicial remedies for enforcement of the judgment, we have deliberately refrained from advising them to initiate contempt proceedings, sincerely hoping that the matter would be resolved administratively in a fair and expeditious manner.

In these circumstances, we earnestly request your goodself to kindly take up the matter once again with the BSNL Corporate Office and the Department of Telecommunications so that the judgment of the Hon'ble CAT Ahmedabad may be implemented at the earliest, preferably within **one month** from the receipt of this communication.

We sincerely believe that an administrative resolution is always preferable to avoidable litigation. However, should the matter remain unresolved even after the above period, we may be left with no option but to seek the intervention of the higher authorities in BSNL and the Department of Telecommunications for early implementation of the judgment. We are confident that such a course will not become necessary and that justice will be extended to the affected pensioners without any further delay.

We shall remain grateful for your kind and sympathetic consideration.
